Learning outcomes

General competences

The undergraduate study programme in administrative law is intended for the acquisition of basic knowledge of administrative law, public administration and the state, which will be upgraded with knowledge from the areas that are included in the framework of public administration. During their studies, students will get acquainted with the basics of administrative law, administrative procedural law, state regulation, human rights law, basics of public administration, legal regulation of public services, civil servant law, tax procedural law, misdemeanor law and administrative dispute and European constitutional law.

Subject-specific competences

The first year as an introduction to the study will be based primarily on subjects that offer basic knowledge of the essence of law, administrative law and public administration, state and local self-government, and human rights law. On this basis, students will also acquire other knowledge in the field of administrative sciences in the next two years to pursue the profession, as mentioned above, or to continue their studies at the postgraduate level. Within the Administrative Law program, the Faculty also envisages the implementation of practical training. The faculty is already strongly connected with practice within the framework of agreements and will continue to work towards the application of theoretical concepts and models in practical (everyday) life. At the same time, the Faculty will encourage the students to base topics for different forms of exercises and seminars on practical examples from everyday life. In the third year, the time for the preparation of the diploma thesis will be specially determined, which will also be especially credit-evaluated.

Assessment and completion

Students' knowledge is assessed by means of practical exercises and seminar papers, and also via products, projects, performances, services, etc. and by examinations. Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5-1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).
