Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to:

- undertake autonomous analytical work,
- analyse social phenomena,
- advise on various trends in social events, development and management,
- synthesise knowledge in a specific field and apply it in the resolution of a specific problem,
- synthesise and contextualise analytical findings,
- undertake, coordinate and organise research,
- use various research methods and techniques,
- demonstrate broad, critical and reflective understanding of military organisation and civil defence, structures and functioning, (legal) norms and institutions and the dynamics of development of international and national security,
- express themselves in writing,
- make a public presentation and argue a point of view,
- express themselves orally,
- give clear, active and well-argued presentations,
- work with others in a spirit of cooperation,
- respect the opinions of others and fulfil an agreed role within a team or group,
- break down, determine the sequence of and coordinate work tasks, and select methods and modes of work in accordance with the standards of the profession,
- master, manage and mediate conflicts,
- negotiate, argue and formulate negotiating positions,
- work flexibly in all social environments and in different cultural contexts, including international cooperation,
- adopt an interdisciplinary approach and demonstrate understanding of cultural plurality,
- demonstrate knowledge of foreign languages and use technical defence studies terminology in Slovene and English,
- show creativity and initiative in selecting and analysing the key security problems of modern society,
- lead and show leadership (in particular in the context of the military module where competences are developed for: coordination, organisation, work with colleagues, advising and managing).

Assessment and completion

Students' knowledge is assessed by means of practical exercises and seminar papers, and also via

products, projects, performances, services, etc. and by examinations. Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

In order to progress to the next year, students must have completed all course units from the current year, for a total of 60 credits.

Transitions

Second-cycle master's study programmes (SQF level 8)

Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all course units in the subjects in which they are enrolled and write a bachelor's thesis.
