## Learning outcomes

**Qualification level** 

The qualification holder will be able to: (general competences)

- demonstrate communication skills, including intercultural communication,
- participate in teamwork and take the initiative,
- cooperate with authority in the preparation and organisation of project work,
- demonstrate proficiency in the use of information technology,
- show independence, initiative and dynamism of ideas,
- express themselves in technical and journalistic contexts,

(subject-specific competences)

- demonstrate knowledge of the rudiments of social science theories and theories of culture,
- demonstrate knowledge of the history and development of sociological and culturological thought,
- demonstrate knowledge of quantitative and qualitative methodologies of sociological and culturological research,
- coherently apply sociological knowledge and fundamental sociological concepts in practice,
- autonomously understand new social and cultural phenomena and place them in existing theoretical and problem-specific frameworks of sociological science,
- demonstrate knowledge of the social and cultural history of Europe,
- demonstrate understanding of the processes of globalisation and relationships between the global and local,
- analyse visual and other cultural representation; place cultural artefacts in context, interpret them and link them to broader social and cultural processes,
- reflect on national identity and the formation of national affiliations in a comparative and historical context,
- demonstrate a feeling for the cultural diversity of human society and adapt conceptual apparatus to concrete social and cultural environments.

#### **Assessment and completion**

Students' knowledge is assessed by means of practical exercises and seminar papers, and also via products, projects, performances, services, etc. and by examinations. Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

#### **Progression**

In order to progress to the second year, students must have completed course units from the programme totalling 60 credits, which they are expected to complete in the first two semesters. In order to progress to the third year, students must have completed course units from the programme totalling 120 credits, which they are expected to complete in the first four semesters.

#### **Transitions**

Second-cycle master's study programmes (SQF level 8)

### **Condition for obtaining certificate**

In order to complete the programme, candidates must complete all course units prescribed by the study programme and the syllabuses of subjects included in the programme. Candidates graduate with an oral defence of a written bachelor's thesis.
