Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to: (general competences)

Assessment and completion

Students' knowledge is assessed by means of practical exercises and seminar papers, and also via products, projects, performances, services, etc. and by examinations. Examination performance is graded

as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

In order to progress to the second year students must have completed 45 credits; to progress to the third year students must have passed all examinations in first-year subjects and completed 48 credits from second-year examinations.

Transitions

Second-cycle master's study programmes (SQF level 8)

Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all prescribed course units and successfully defend a bachelor's seminar paper, for a total of at least 180 credits.
