Learning outcomes

Qualification holders are qualified to:

- autonomously collect, select, process, analyse and arrange relevant information for its appropriate and comprehensible presentation and interpretation (oral, written, using various media), e.g. in articulated, argued, analytical and synthetic articles in scholarly and professional publications,
- prepare, implement and manage technical, analytical and research work designed to provide comprehensive answers to research questions,
- address problems successfully and comprehensively in a professionally sound manner.

Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

Students may enrol in the second year if they have completed all first-year course units, and may enrol in the third year if they have completed all first- and second-year course units.

Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all course units prescribed by the study programme.
