- a completed professional higher education programme (under the former programme in other fields), if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies: these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits.

### **Assessment and completion**

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

### **Progression**

In order to progress from the first to the second year, students must have completed all course units prescribed by the curriculum and individual syllabuses for the first year, for a total of 60 credits.

### **Transitions**

Third-cycle doctoral study programmes (SQF level 10)

### **Condition for obtaining certificate**

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all course units prescribed by the study programme and individual subject syllabuses, for a total of 60 credits. Since this is a two-subject study programme, in order to complete the overall programme students must also complete all course units in the other discipline, amounting to 60 credits, for a total of 120 credits.
