Admission requirements

- A completed first-cycle bi-disciplinary academic higher education programme in the same disciplines (180 credits); or
- a completed first-cycle two-subject academic higher education programme in the same disciplines (240 credits); in this case up to 60 credits may be recognised, depending on the first-cycle course units completed; or
- any other completed first-cycle academic higher education programme in another relevant field (linguistics, social sciences and humanities), if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of 10 to 60 credits; or
- any other first-cycle academic higher education programme in another field, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits; or
- a completed professional higher education programme under the former programme in relevant fields (linguistics, social sciences and humanities), if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of 10 to 60 credits; or
- a completed professional higher education programme (under the former programme in other fields), if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits.

Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to:
(general competences)

- perform logical and abstract analyses, syntheses and evaluations,
- express in depth their knowledge of both specialist fields in written and oral form and evaluate them critically,

- competently transfer intra- and interdisciplinary knowledge into practice,
- independently enhance, refine and link acquired knowledge and qualifications with various professional fields,
- contextualise and independently supplement information,
- transfer own knowledge and skills to other problem areas (ability to transfer),

- organise and lead expert groups,

- demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the history of the discipline and of the origin, importance and critiques of the fundamental concepts of the discipline, and familiarity with the current dilemmas and modern theoretical scope of the discipline,
- demonstrate mastery of methods of research and analysis and understanding of the central concepts of the theory and philosophy of the science and the principal theoretical models for the interpretation of empirically collected material,
- demonstrate familiarity with interdisciplinary approaches and integrate knowledge from different fields,
- read technical texts and write various forms of scholarly and technical texts,
- demonstrate the methodological and conceptual skills required for critical analysis of concepts and phenomena in the domestic and foreign environments and of processes at the local, regional and global levels,
- study culture and ways of life and demonstrate understanding of cultural, political and economic processes and phenomena,
- develop skills and expertise in the application of knowledge in specific technical fields.

Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5-1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

In order to progress from the first to the second year of a second-cycle two-subject study programme, students must have completed all course units prescribed by the curriculum and individual syllabuses for the first year, for a total of 60 credits.

Transitions

Third-cycle doctoral study programmes (SQF level 10)

Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all course units prescribed by the study programme and the syllabuses of individual subjects, for a total of 60 credits. Since this is a two-subject study programme, in order to complete the overall programme students must also complete all course units in the other discipline, amounting to 60 credits, for a total of 120 credits.
