Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to: (general competences)

- demonstrate familiarity with and understanding of cultural and social processes and perform complex analysis of them,
- apply methodological tools, i.e. implement, coordinate and organise research and use a range of research methods and techniques,
- formulate original ideas, concepts and solutions to specific problems,
- demonstrate strategic focus, i.e. the ability to anticipate events originating from cultural dynamics and the ability to offer solutions in order to prevent their negative consequences,
- demonstrate a capacity for ethical reflection and a commitment to professional ethics in the social environment, while observing the principles of non-discrimination and multiculturalism,
- develop communication abilities and skills for communication with different environments,
- work as part of a team, i.e. show willingness to cooperate, respect the opinions of others and fulfil an agreed role within a team or group,

- demonstrate understanding of cultural phenomena and their connection with the structure and development of societies,
- apply and combine knowledge from different disciplines,
- demonstrate understanding of different theoretical approaches and apply them when addressing

- form contacts in a multicultural environment and communicate with actors from different cultural environments.
- use information and communication technologies and systems in the field of culture,

- demonstrate understanding of intercultural information and use it proficiently,
- demonstrate understanding of the relationships between individuals and groups in different cultural environments,
- demonstrate organisational and leadership skills for guiding work in a multicultural environment,
- demonstrate cultural empathy, i.e. understanding of ideas, values and mentalities from different cultural environments.

Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

Students may progress to the next year if by the end of the academic year they have completed all course units prescribed by the study programme for progression to the next year.
