## Admission requirements

- A completed first-cycle study programme in International Relations or European Studies and a total of 240 credits; or
- a completed first-cycle study programme consisting of 240 credits in any other field, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed those course units that are essential for further study; or
- a completed first-cycle study programme in any field consisting of 180 credits, where the candidate must make up the missing 60 credits by completing the Social Sciences Preparatory Programme; or
- a completed four-year professional higher education programme offered before the introduction of the Bologna reform and completed by the 2015/2016 academic year at the latest, in any field, if before enrolment the candidate has completed those course units that are essential for further study; or
- a completed three-year professional higher education programme or specialisation following a short-cycle higher education programme offered before the introduction of the Bologna reform and completed by the 2015/2016 academic year at the latest, where candidates must make up the missing 60 credits by enrolling in the Social Sciences Preparatory Programme.

## Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to:

- demonstrate broad general knowledge of the social sciences,
- demonstrate excellent knowledge of the international community in its developmental and structural dimensions,
- demonstrate knowledge of the functioning of international institutions and their organisational and administrative cultures and procedures,
- think independently and work autonomously in the field of international relations and in the international community,
- demonstrate mastery of formal and informal decision-making processes and the rules that govern them,
- demonstrate a broad analytical capacity in questions of international relations,
- synthesise analytical findings,
- demonstrate knowledge and understanding of other cultures, societies and political communities,
- demonstrate a capacity for organisation and leadership to enable familiarity with and harmonisation

- of different fields of international relations,
- demonstrate active knowledge of foreign languages,
- communicate in social and public spheres.

## Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5-1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

## Progression

The programme has a one-year duration so there is no progression to subsequent years.

## Transitions

Third-cycle doctoral study programmes (SQF level 10)

## Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all course units in all subjects in which they have enrolled and successfully defend a master's thesis via a public presentation.
