Admission requirements	 A completed first-cycle academic higher education programme in Polish studies (Bologna three-year programme); or another completed first-cycle academic higher education programme in a related field (180 credits); candidates must demonstrate adequate knowledge of the Polish language; or any other first-cycle academic higher education programme in another field, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits; or a completed professional higher education programme under the old programme in another field.

Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to:

- demonstrate a capacity for analytical, synthetic, logical and critical thinking,
- demonstrate a capacity for critical reading, evaluation and interpretation of different kinds of texts,

Second level

- give a public presentation in a confident and authoritative manner
- carry out independent research and use scientific methods innovatively,
- collect, select and process material within a specialist field,
- demonstrate good knowledge of scholarly apparatus and use it appropriately,
- constantly improve and build on knowledge acquired,
- correctly assess own abilities and skills and those of others,
- demonstrate openness to alternative views and solutions,
- skilfully transfer acquired knowledge and skills into practice and into other problem areas,
- independently search for new sources of knowledge in a professional and academic field,
- · demonstrate familiarity with modern information and communication technologies and use them,
- win, conceive and lead projects,
- participate in international research projects.

Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

In order to progress from the first to the second year of a second-cycle two-subject study programme, students must have completed all course units prescribed by the curriculum and individual syllabuses for the first year, for a total of 60 credits.

Transitions

Third-cycle doctoral study programmes (SQF level 10)

Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all course units prescribed by the study programme and individual subject syllabuses, for a total of 60 credits. Since this is a two-subject study programme, in order to complete the overall programme students must also complete all course units in the other discipline, amounting to 60 credits, for a total of 120 credits.
