#### **Learning outcomes**

- demonstrate artistic expression in the choral field,
- foster awareness of the phenomenon of music and its various manifestations,
- demonstrate thorough understanding of music in its artistic, scientific and technical dimensions,
- foster awareness of musical language to the dynamic and creative use of music theory, history and fields of musical reproduction,
- demonstrate knowledge, understanding and application of music theory and formal principles,
- develop listening and music-reading skills and musical memory,
- demonstrate knowledge and understanding of world and Slovene music history,
- demonstrate knowledge and understanding of and evaluate musical works from world and Slovene musical literature,
- develop broad possibilities for the functional application of music-making subjects in music activities in formal education and other forms of music-making,
- play music individually and in a group,
- develop musical independence,
- foster awareness of the values of Slovene and world musical culture; demonstrate knowledge, understanding and application of various methods of evaluation of musical achievements.

## **Assessment and completion**

Examination performance is scored as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

## **Progression**

In order to progress to the second year, students must complete all compulsory course units, totalling 60

ECTS credits.

## **Condition for obtaining certificate**

To complete their studies, students must complete all course units contained in the study programme (120 ECTS credits by the curriculum).
