- Diploma in first-cycle study programmes in the field of Italian studies or translation in the Italian language, consisting of 240 ECTS credits or in an equivalent foreign study programme; or
- diploma in first-cycle study programmes in the field of Italian studies or translation consisting of 180 ECTS credits or in an equivalent foreign study programme, if prior to enrolment the candidate completes course units essential for further study totalling 60 ECTS credits; or
- diploma in first-cycle study programmes in another field consisting of 180 ECTS credits, if prior to enrolment the candidate completes additional education in linguistic skills and abilities in Italian consisting of 60 ECTS credits; or
- diploma in a first-cycle study programme in another field consisting of 240 ECTS credits, if prior to enrolment the candidate completes additional education in linguistic skills and abilities in Italian consisting of 45 ECTS credits; or
- diploma in a previous academic higher education programme (adopted before 11 June 2004) in the field of Italian studies (or relevant language study programmes) or in an equivalent foreign study programme; or
- diploma in a previous academic higher education programme (adopted before 11 June 2004) in another professional or in an equivalent foreign study programme, if prior to enrolment the candidate completes course units essential for further study.
