- a completed professional higher education programme, adopted before 11 June 2004, in a relevant field (art education or a study programme in the field of the fine arts) consisting of 180 credits; prior to enrolment in this programme, candidates must complete a foundation year; or
- a completed professional higher education programme in another field, consisting of 180 ECTS credits, adopted before 11 June 2004; prior to enrolment candidates must pass a test of ability and complete a foundation year.

Assessment and completion

Examination performance is scored as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

Since this is a one-year programme, no conditions for progression are defined within the programme.

Condition for obtaining certificate

Students complete their studies when they have met all requirements prescribed by the study programme, written and successfully defended a master's thesis and completed a total of 60 ECTS credits.
