Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to:

- demonstrate advanced understanding and critical evaluation of the broader social and economic framework of education activities,
- participate in the updating and development of school curricula, and be involved in research and development activities organised at the school, local, national and international levels,
- apply pedagogical theories to the resolution of specific work-related problems.

Assessment and completion

Examination performance is scored as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5-1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

In order to progress to the second year, students must complete at least 48 ECTS credits from the curriculum of a single-subject study programme.

Transitions

Third-cycle doctoral study programmes (SQF level 10)

Condition for obtaining certificate

Students complete their studies when they have successfully met all requirements laid down by the study programme and accumulated at least 120 ECTS credits.
