SET DESIGN

- demonstrate detailed knowledge of relationships between all components involved in the creation of a production or performance,
- demonstrate knowledge of the characteristics and possibilities opened up by the "performance space",
- recognise the importance of the relationship between event and space, space and story, the space of performance and the performance of space,
- transform outline concepts into artistic language,
- demonstrate knowledge of the complex process of set design from conception to execution,
- understand, coordinate and direct creative processes in workshops and staging locations,
- design and develop creative ideas,
- collaborate creatively with the creators of the project (director, actors, set design, lighting designer, dramaturge, etc.),
- demonstrate proficiency in all the practical and technical tasks of the set designer (sketch, drawing, detail, etc.),
- communicate set design ideas in workshops (selection of materials, method of treatment, etc.),
- analytically and critically assess own creative procedures in individual phases of planning and execution,

#### COSTUME DESIGN

- demonstrate detailed knowledge of the relationships between costume and: text, director, actors, space, staging, audience,
- demonstrate knowledge of connections and influences between clothes, costumes, literature, drama and staging,
- demonstrate knowledge of different practices in theatre, film, etc. and directorial procedures,
- demonstrate knowledge of styles of dress and behaviour in connection with political, social and technological factors in different historical periods and geographical areas,
- demonstrate understanding of the connection between clothes and costumes and material culture in the broader sense and fine art in the narrower sense,
- seek, apply and transform various historical and contemporary sources and models into costume design solutions,
- design and develop creative ideas,
- transform outline concepts into artistic language,
- demonstrate understanding of the psychophysical structure of the costume,
- take into account and understand the connection between costume, the personality of the actor and the creation of a dramatic figure,

- demonstrate understanding of the function of the individual costume and of the overall appearance of costumes in relation to the concept of the staging, dramaturgy, set design, lighting, music, etc.,
- collaborate creatively with the creators of the project (director, actors, set design, lighting designer, dramaturge, etc.),
- demonstrate knowledge of the importance and possibilities of the different contextual (directorial concept) and visual (costume design concept) expressions of costume design as part of the overall appearance in both conception (sketch) and execution (costume),
- demonstrate knowledge of the complex process of costume design from conception to execution,
- demonstrate proficiency in all the practical and technical tasks of the costume designer (sketch, drawing, detail, etc.),
- communicate costume design ideas in costume workshops (selection of materials, method of treatment, etc.),
- understand, coordinate and direct creative processes in workshops and staging locations,
- analytically and critically assess own creative procedures in individual phases of planning and execution of costume design,
- develop awareness of responsibility for the artistic and production dimension of the planned costume design concept and execution,
- compare the results of own work with the work of other creators and place own original creations in a broader ideo-aesthetic context,
- develop awareness of the ethical dimension of media creation.

#### Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

#### **Progression**

Students may progress to the next higher year if by the end of the academic year they have completed all requirements defined by the study programme for progression to the next year.
