## Admission requirements

- A completed first-cycle two-subject academic higher education programme in the same disciplines (Polish studies, Czech studies, etc.) (180 credits); or
- a completed first-cycle two-subject academic higher education programme in the same disciplines (240 credits); in this case up to 60 credits may be recognised, depending on the first-cycle course units completed; or
- any other completed first-cycle academic higher education programme in another relevant field (linguistics, social sciences and humanities), if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of 10 to 60 credits; or
- any other first-cycle academic higher education programme in another field, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits; or
- a completed professional higher education programme under the former programme in a relevant field (linguistics, social sciences and humanities), if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of 10 to 60 credits; or
- a completed professional higher education programme under the former programme in another field, if prior to enrolment the candidate has completed course units essential for second-cycle studies; these are determined with reference to how different the field is, and consist of up to 60 credits.

## Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to:

- perform logical and abstract analyses, syntheses and evaluations,
- express in depth their knowledge of both specialist fields in written and oral form and evaluate them critically,
- competently transfer intra- and interdisciplinary knowledge into practice,

- independently enhance, refine and link acquired knowledge and qualifications with various professional fields,
- contextualise and independently supplement information,
- transfer own knowledge and skills to other problem areas (ability to transfer),
- resolve problems, conflicts and work tasks in an intra- and interdisciplinary manner,
- approach problem-solving as part of a team,
- organise and lead expert groups,
- perform (self-)evaluation and (self-)assessment, and think critically and holistically,
- find new sources of knowledge independently and interpret and apply them in professional and academic fields,
- use ICT professionally and effectively in searching for, selecting, processing, presenting and disseminating information,
- ensure the quality of own work and raise quality standards in the work environment,
- perceive and innovatively resolve complex problems and conflict situations and make decisions competently and autonomously,
- react appropriately to new situations and create new concepts,
- competently receive the opinions of others and respond to them in a considered manner,
- assess own competences and those of others,
- work efficiently and economically,
- apply scientific methods innovatively,
- win, conceive and lead projects,
- develop management and leadership skills and develop high-quality and effective interpersonal relations inside and outside the professional field,
- monitor current events in the media critically and in depth,
- make creative sense of data and synthesise information,
- develop intercultural communication in formal and non-formal situations.

## Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5-1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

## Progression

In order to progress to the next year of a two-subject study programme, students must have completed course units totalling 90% of the credits prescribed by the curriculum for the individual year (i.e. 54 out of 60 credits).

Third-cycle doctoral study programmes (SQF level 10)

## Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all course units prescribed by the study programme.
