Learning outcomes

The qualification holder will be able to:

- demonstrate understanding of complex existential, individual, social, cultural and religious problems, their contexts, differences and connections,
- demonstrate understanding of texts, their message and their diversity,
- demonstrate understanding of dialogue as the fundamental mode of coexistence in the modern world.
- demonstrate understanding of alternatives and realistic solutions,
- demonstrate expertise through an autonomous theoretical/methodological, critical and self-critical approach to problems,
- acquire, record, document, use and evaluate sources of knowledge and information,
- use scholarly apparatus,
- use information technology,
- show awareness of the environment and analyse positions,
- demonstrate a sense of group dynamics, participate in and integrate into a group working environment,
- lead the work of a team in a humanities or social sciences field,
- demonstrate a sense of the heterogeneity and homogeneity of different social groups,
- demonstrate communicative ability and coordinate different interests,
- work with people, in particular with regard to their spiritual needs,

- transfer knowledge and competences in various ways,

Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

Students may carry over up to 5 first-year credits to the second year; up to 6 credits may be carried over to the third year, provided all first-year course units have been completed; 7 credits may be carried over to the fourth year provided all second-year course units have been completed; 8 credits may be carried over to the fifth year provided all fourth-year course units have been completed.

Transitions

Third-cycle doctoral study programmes (SQF level 10)

Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the study programme, students must complete all course units prescribed by the programme. This means completing all 300 credits, passing the bachelor's examination and writing and successfully defending a master's thesis.
