Learning outcomes

- The qualification holders are able to carry out autonomous research in accordance with the standards of domestic and foreign scholarly tradition and will have acquired knowledge in specialist fields of linguistics and literary studies and broadened their general knowledge of all theoretical and historical fields of Slavonic studies.
- The qualification holders also contribute with their knowledge to the development and renovation of Slavonic studies (including through participation in scholarly publishing in Slavonic studies), and to its penetration into education or the school system.

Assessment and completion

Examination performance is graded as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

Progression

Students who have completed all course units (examinations or seminar papers) prescribed by the individual study programme may enrol in the next year of the course.

Condition for obtaining certificate

In order to complete the programme, students must complete all course units prescribed by the individual study programme (examinations, seminar papers).
