#### **Learning outcomes**

#### **Assessment and completion**

Students' knowledge is assessed by means of practical exercises and seminar papers, and also via products, projects, performances, services, etc. and by examinations. Examination performance is scored as follows: 10 (excellent); 9 (very good: above-average knowledge but with some mistakes); 8 (very good: solid results); 7 (good); 6 (adequate: knowledge satisfies minimum criteria); 5–1 (inadequate). In order to pass an examination, a candidate must achieve a grade between adequate (6) and excellent (10).

#### **Progression**

A general condition for progression from one year to the next is completion of all practical exercises. In order to enrol in a higher year the student must complete at least 54 credits from the last year attended and all credits from previous years.
